The Technical sessions started with the first technical lecture by Gold Sponsor M/s Cardolite Specialty Chemicals India LLP on topic 'Chemistry for Green Technologies for coating market' presentation by Mr. Paras Patel. The presentation was split into three segments namely introduction to Cardolite and CNSL Technology. New multi-functional modified/diluent for high performance coating and adhesion and Cardolite polyols performance in anti-corrosive and pipe coatings. The presentation covered the diluents performance study in coating the chemical resistance and use of products in Water borne screeds and floor systems. The presentation was summed up with a study on Cardolite Polyols its application, mechanical properties. UV colour stability, chemical resistance, thermal resistance and hydrolytic stability. After the lecture Mr. Patel was felicitated with a memento and the session ended with a lucky draw.

The second Technical Lecture was conducted by our Silver sponsor APS Minerals by Dr. Anil Bansal on topic 'Cost Effective Engineered Multi Functional Filler'. The primary focus on presentation was to emphasize cost reduction the creation of high quality coatings and stress on the importance of import substitution. His presentation covered using high performance minerals, which offer multiple properties such as gloss with opacity water resistance and heat reflection. The presentation also highlighted coloured minerals including coloured marble grains, and coloured quartz for texture application epoxy tile grout, floor coating etc. also include precipitated Baso4, Iclay21, calcined kaolin, natural red oxide, Talc and zinc phosphate. Overall Dr. Bansal's presentation shed light on innovative range of products offered by APS minerals and their significant contribution for the coating and additives industry. After the lecture Dr. Bansal was felicitated with a memento followed by a lucky draw.

The third Technical Lecture was conducted by an eminent speaker Dr. Tejas Shah from ISTAR Vallabh Vidhyanagar. His topic was 'Recent Trends in Surface Coating'. Dr. Tejas Shah faculty of ISTAR and director of Usha Coating explained the present Indian paint market size and what it would be by 2029. He elucidated opportunities and shared

He talked about Self-Healing paint, Anti-microbial Paint, Smart Paint, Solar paint and Self-Cleaning Paint. Before concluding his speech, he hoped that the members would benefit from such Knowledge sharing seminar (KSS) organized by IPCA Guj. and take their business to new heights. After the end of the session Dr. Shah was duly felicitated.

The fourth and last lecture was conducted by Mr. Avnish Nagori having an expertise for solvent, explosive and poison licensing. He provided brief information on solvent explosives and poison licensing enriching the understanding of all IPCA members present. He covered major area such as introduction about PESO, requirement of PESO license/certificate, classification of petroleum products salient point of petroleum rules 2002, definition of bulk and non-bulk solvent, solvent license procedure and documentation, solvent license issuance authority and poison license procedure and documentation. After the lecture Mr. Nagori was duly felicitated and thanked for creating due awareness on the various developments in this sphere. Table space was duly provided to all the event supporters and there
